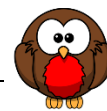




Spring 1 Homework Year One

Draw your lounge – does it have a rectangle telly, a square table.

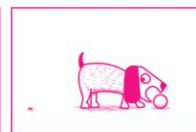
English

Make a storyboard



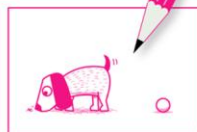
Doggo chases his ball.

Doggo investigates. He sniffs around.



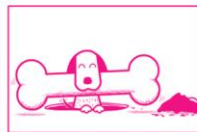
He begins to dig.
