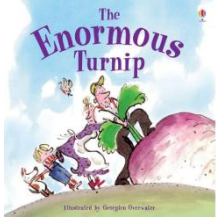




## Homework Grid- Year 1 Summer 1

Use a range of stones, pebbles, shells or leaved to create transitional artwork in the style of Andy Goldsworthy. Use leaves and sticks to make a face or animal shape.	Focus on multiplication finding the totals of groups of 2, 5 and 10 objects. Pasta/ lego bricks are good for this. Can you make 2,3,4, or 5 equal groups of 2s,5s or 10s. How many are there altogether?	Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s. Can you share a video of your counting on Tapestry.
