



A message from Mrs French

What a great week of remote learning we have had, ending with the excitement of World Book Day and St Piran's Day. Next week, we are looking forward to welcoming you all back to school. Please can I remind you of the key points below to ensure our school remains as safe as possible. Many restrictions remain in place in compliance with our risk assessment. I would appreciate your support in working with us to ensure safe working practices.

- **One parent** per family to drop off/ collect
- Please stick to your drop off and collection time, it will ensure that there's a steady flow of people on site to avoid unnecessary crowding
- For collection, the gates will be open at 14:50. Parents are asked not to arrive before 14:50 as this would result in congestion. To support the safe environment, parents must adhere to the collection and drop off times
- There is an expectation that no child or adult should gather on the school site at any time
- Drop off and collection times using one-way system (**enter through pedestrian gate, exit through traffic gate**):

Year 2: Drop off: 08:45, Pick up: 14:50

Year 1: Drop off: 08:50, Pick up: 14:55

Reception: Drop off: 08:55, Pick up: 15:00

- Gates will close promptly at 09:00 am
- If you have siblings please drop them both at the earliest time and pick them both up at the latest time.
- Face masks are required for all adults on site, unless you are exempt from wearing one
- Please park considerately outside school. You should not part on the zig zag lines directly outside school or in the school entrance. This is a pedestrian exit and we must ensure the safety of our children and families.

Please ensure your child comes to school with their PE kit and a clearly labelled water bottle. We will be providing snack and fruit for the children.
