The EYFS at Biscovey and Nursery Infants' Academy

At Biscovey Nursery and Infants' Academy we are dedicated to giving children the best start to their academic careers.

We follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework which sets standards for the learning, development and care of children from birth to 5 years old. It provides children with the wide range of knowledge and skills that provide a secure foundation for their academic careers and plants the roots to support progress through school and their life to come.

There are seven areas of learning and development that make up the Early Years Foundation Stage.

Prime Areas;

- Communication and language;
- Physical development; and
- Personal, social and emotional development.

Specific Areas

- Literacy;
- Mathematics;
- Understanding the world; and
- Expressive arts and design.

Underpinning everything that we do in the early years are the 'Characteristics of Effective Learning', which are;

- Playing and exploring children use all their senses to investigate and explore
- Active learning- children concentrate and keep on trying
- Creating and thinking critically children develop their own ideas and problem-solving skills.

To support children's development, teachers consider the individual needs, interests and each child's stage of development. They then use this information to provide a challenging and inspiring curriculum for all children. The EYFS is a play-based curriculum, where practitioners use a mix of adult-led and child-initiated activities each day.



Tapestry

At Biscovey we work hard to develop very strong partnerships with parents/ carers. Tapestry enables us to share your child's learning journal online. Parents are able to add photos, videos and comments from home at any point during the year.

Once, your child starts in Reception, you will be given parent access to Tapestry. There is an app that can be downloaded to your smart device for free. This makes adding photos and videos from home really easy. Alternatively, you can login to Tapestry online on a computer. We will set weekly home learning tasks, via Tapestry for the children to complete at home to support learning beyond the classroom. Please complete the form below:

Home Learning

Each week a small piece of home learning will be set for you child. This will be set on Tapestry. Once your child has completed it we would love you to share it on Tapestry. Your child's teacher can then comment on the work and celebrate their work in school. We love sharing with the rest of the class what your children have been up to at home. The children love seeing themselves on the whiteboard, discussing their adventures with their friends.

Read Write Inc

At Biscovey Nursery and Infants' Academy the children learn to read through the Read, Write Inc programme. Read Write Inc Phonics is an exciting and dynamic approach that teaches children to read and write. First, children learn the common sounds in the English language and how to sound-blend words for reading, at the same time they develop skills of handwriting and spelling. They will progress to read and understand storybooks containing words that they can decode so that they achieve early success in reading.

Your child will start by learning sounds from Set 1 which they have learnt in school. These will be sent home to be practiced. As they progress with their sounds, children will move onto reading books that are matched to their phonic ability.

Free School Meals

All Reception aged children will receive a Universal Free School Meal each day. At the beginning of the day children will choose their lunch from the menu. We will talk through the options with your children. All staff will support the children to get their lunch and ensure that they are happy and settled in the hall.

At Biscovey, we have a wide selection of healthy lunches available each day. These include; a hot main meal option, a vegetarian option, jacket potato or a sandwich. We cater for all children and ensure that kitchen staff are aware of any allergies or dietary requirements. There is a separate form to fill out for allergies so that we can ensure your child's needs are taken care of.

Tuck

Each morning the children in Reception can choose to have some tuck. This includes a healthy snack with fruit and milk or water. We ask for a contribution of £1.50 per week. Please pay this via your Parent Pay account. All allergies and dietary needs are carefully considered at tuck times. Drinks are available throughout the day so there is no need to send a drinks bottle for your child. However, if you do send in a bottle, we encourage for it to be filled with water.

Parent Pay

Once your child starts with us, you will be provided with a login for Parent Pay. Those children moving from the Nursery will continue to use their current Parent Pay account. This is used to pay for tuck weekly or termly and school trips.

Children's Belongings

We encourage independence as part of our curriculum. This includes when dressing for PE and getting belongings ready at home time. To prevent uniform and all of your children's belongings getting mixed up, we ask that you label all of your child's belongings clearly.

Messy Activities

This is a valuable part of school experience. Whilst we do try to ensure that children wear aprons when doing messy activities there might be times when their clothes become wet or dirty. We apologise in advance for this.
